The Neuro-Ophthalmology Virtual Education Library (NOVEL) is an open access, discipline specific repository of multimedia (images, videos, lectures and other digital media) to support neuro-ophthalmology professionals, educators, students and patients. This collaboration between the North American Neuro-Ophthalmology Society (NANOS) and the Eccles Health Sciences Library of the University of Utah creates a unique model for digital collection development. NANOS members are enthusiastic about the project and have committed a great deal of time and energy in providing content, metadata, and peer review.

■ The entire archive of the Journal of Neuro-Ophthalmology (JCNO1981-1993 and JNO 1994-2010) are now available on the NOVEL Web site: http://NOVEL.utah.edu/jno Agreements were made with the journal publishers to obtain the rights to the articles from all issues, with a one year embargo on current material. The archive is complete and will add each new issue as the one year embargo is lifted. This provides a permanent repository for the journal, and integrates the literature with the educational material.
